Tournament Style:

1. Two divisions with 4 teams per division.
2. Preliminary round consists of round robin within each division.
3. The Semi-finals will consist of the two top ranked teams in each division.
4. The four advancing teams will be ranked based on points (per system shown in item 5). Once ranked, the semi-final games will be Pool A Rank 1 vs Pool B Rank 2 and Pool A Rank 2 vs Pool B Rank 1. Winner of semi-finals advance to championship.
5. Team ranks will be determined by highest team points – Win = 2, Tie = 1, Loss = 0. Should there be a tie at the end of the round robin the following will take place:
 - a. Wins
 - b. Head to head (should there be a 3 way tie proceed to (c))
 - c. Least Penalty Minutes.
 - d. Plus/Minus
 - e. Least Goals Against
6. Semi-final overtime rules:
 - a. 5 minute stop time 3 on 3 sudden victory overtime (remain in same end zones).
 - b. 5 player shootout.
 - c. Continue 1 for 1 until winner (must use entire roster before repeat shooter).
7. Championship rules:
 - a. 10 minute straight time 3 on 3 sudden victory.
 - b. 5 player shootout.
 - c. Continue 1 for 1 until winner. (Repeat shooters can be used after the 5 player shootout during the finals)

Game Play Items:

1. Three minute warm up.
2. Three 15 minute straight time periods.
3. Last 5 minutes of the third period is stop time (changes are permitted during this time).
1. Should there be a 5 or more goal spread (i.e. 5-0) the stop time portion in the third is to remain straight. The Jennifer Collins Classic Committee reserves the right to at any time, using their discretion, but not limited to, call a game to an end, keep the game running straight time, ask a player to leave the game, ask a coach to leave the game, etc.
4. Standard hockey Canada line change procedure will be followed (15 seconds). At the discretion of the official, delays may be penalized for **delay of game**.
5. At the discretion of the official, intentional delays will stop the clock (& add time back to original stoppage). Penalty may result.
6. Ice cleaning following each game.
7. **Slap shots are NOT allowed. (up to knees)**

Eligibility Requirements:

1. Players must be **19** years of age or older.
2. A waiver must be signed by each player prior to start of first game.
3. No Junior or contracted players (i.e. if a player participated in the current 2024-2025 season in 1 or more games in Junior, University, or any other contracted leagues they are NOT permitted to play).

4. Proof of age may be required.
5. A player must play at least 1 round robin game in order to play in non-round robin games.
6. Players & Goalies may not play in more than one division or on multiple teams.
7. Team rosters cannot be over 16 players/goaltenders TOTAL. **Rosters are final at the start of the team's first game time.** Roster substitutions are not allowed throughout tournament. (i.e. if injury occurs, no substitute is permitted).

Tournament Specific Penalty Rules:

1. Teams get one 30 second timeout each during finals only. NO TIMEOUTS IN ROUND ROBIN.
2. Timeclock will stop for any stoppage over 30 seconds in length and time placed back on board. This is for unexpected events only (ex, injuries, delays, etc).
3. There is NO automatic whistle for puck contact with goaltender's helmet.
4. 4 coaches max on player's bench.
5. Three minor penalties (any kind) in one game result in game ejection (remainder of game). A double minor penalty will be considered two penalties for this ruling purpose.
6. A misconduct penalty results in automatic game ejection.
7. Two game ejections result in tournament ejection.
8. Minor penalty during straight and stop time are three and two minutes, respectively.
9. Fighting is automatic tournament ejection (officials' discretion).
10. No body checking allowed. Body positioning is allowed to battle for puck possession.
11. Tournament committee reserves the right to review and retract any potential tournament ejection.
12. Unsportsmanlike conduct rule:
 - a. **1st offense** - Any player to disrespect the game, officials or Jennifer Collins Classic Committee Member will be assessed a minor penalty or at the discretion of the referee, a game ejection penalty. This 1st offense also results in a team warning.
 - b. **2nd offense** – An automatic game ejection (regardless of the player) will be assessed to the player responsible for the unsportsmanlike actions.
13. Straight time penalty rules (during straight time play only):
 - a. Minor penalty is 3 minutes straight time once play commences.
 - b. Major penalty is 7 minutes straight time once play commences. Major penalty cannot be canceled with opposing team goal.
14. Remaining rules are to follow Hockey Canada standards.
15. Any altercations on or off the ice, could result in the individual being removed from the tournament. The Jennifer Collins Classic Committee Reserves the right, at their discretion, to remove an individual from the tournament or ban from the tournament who have been involved in an altercation on or off the ice throughout the entirety of the weekend.

Tournament Perks and Awards:

1. Player of the Game awards for each team (as selected by opposing team captain).
2. Fair Team of the Tournament Award (as selected by Forward family).
3. Forward of the Tournament Award
4. Defenseman of the Tournament Award
5. Goaltender of the Tournament Award

6. Fair Player of the Tournament Award
7. Take home plaque for winning team.
8. The Jennifer Collins Classic Cup for champions.
